Position Description

CityArt is a partnership of the City Center Partnership and the Twin Rivers Council for the Arts to provide free and accessible public art for the community's enjoyment. CityArt programs include the CityArt Walking Sculpture Tour, CityArt On the Go and Public Art Tour. To learn more about CityArt programs, visit cityartmankato.com.

As a CityArt maintenance volunteer you will help clean the beautiful public art sculptures that City Center Mankato has acquired over the past seven years. Maintenance volunteer days will be scheduled several times throughout the spring/summer months to prepare new sculptures for the CityArt Walking Sculpture Tour and provide annual cleaning to permanent sculptures.

Responsibilities

Use soap/water and sculpture cleaning supplies provided by the program to clean and wax sculptures.

Time Commitment

It takes approximately 20-30 minutes to clean one sculpture. Volunteers will be asked to complete at least two sculptures.

Training

Twin Rivers Council for the Arts and the City Center Partnership staff oversee the CityArt programs and volunteers. Staff will schedule, support and supervise volunteers.
