



CityArt Walking Sculpture Tour Installation and Deinstallation Volunteer

Position Description

CityArt is a partnership of the City Center Partnership and Twin Rivers Council for the Arts to provide free and accessible public art for the community's enjoyment. CityArt programs include the CityArt Walking Sculpture Tour, CityArt On the Go and Public Art Tour. To learn more about CityArt programs, visit cityartmankato.com.

Each year the CityArt Walking Sculpture Tour sculptures are deinstalled in the spring (April) and new sculptures are installed (May). The CityArt program relies on teams of volunteer lifters to remove sculptures from their bases and install new artwork onto bases.

Teams begin at 6:00am on a Saturday morning (2018 dates TBD) and are typically done by 9:30am.

It is not required that you be available for both dates, but it is encouraged. We ask that you dress for the weather, as we deinstall and install sculptures rain or shine. We also suggest bringing work gloves as some of the sculptures have jagged edges.

Requirement: Ability to lift at least 50 lbs.
